

API Internship Terms of Service

1. Overview.

API provides the following services to internship applicants 1) advertises open positions with internship hosts, 2) career coaching and ranking selected internship selections, 3) sharing your resume with our internship hosts, 4) Organize interview(s), as applicable, to validate your internship, 5) verify your offer with an employer and draft an offer letter. Once the offer letter is accepted, the applicant is subject to the API Participant policies.

2. Application Process.

Internship applicants applying for an API Internship Program are encouraged to apply to more than one internship selection in order to maximize their opportunity for placement. API does not guarantee placement with a specific internship. Our dedicated Internship Team will provide internship applicants with additional internship opportunities in the same Career Interest Area (defined as an employment experience which utilizes the broad tasks associated with certain occupational responsibilities) as the internship applicant's selection.

API will next inform the internship applicant of an internship offer and an interview will then be scheduled after receipt of the confirmation deposit. API intends to provide the internship offer within 8 weeks of the career coaching session, but API cannot control the response time of the internship applicant or internship host, which could result in delay of the offer.

Provided internship applicants do their part in timely completing the required forms and payments, API guarantees the securement of an internship within the internship applicant's Career Interest Area. If an internship applicant fails to timely complete their onboarding materials or otherwise fails to cooperate with API, API reserves the right to cancel their participation without refund.

API works closely with our internship hosts to communicate the most accurate information about the internship in order for internship applicants to review and make informed decisions regarding their internship selections. API does not have control over whether an internship host will accept an internship applicant. API is not responsible for work tasks, projects or volume of work provided to the intern. If tasks are not aligned with the offer letter, please contact the on-site team or email internships@apiexperience.com and API will facilitate a conversation between the intern and internship host to discuss any discrepancies.
